

733 LETTER OF ENGAGEMENT FOR MITCHELL ROSEN, LMFT

It is agreed that _____, Attorney at Law shall hire Mitchell Rosen, LMFT (Licensed Marriage & Family Therapist and Approved in Riverside County, Orange County & San Bernardino County according to rules 5.220 and 5.225 to facilitate EC 730 evaluations) to perform an EC 733 review of the EC 730 in the case of _____, Case No: _____ . The 730 evaluation is dated: _____ and was conducted by: _____.

Mr. Rosen shall:

1. Read 730 and evaluate if the report was conducted according to the Model Standards of Practice for Child Custody Evaluations approved by the Association of Family and Conciliation Courts Board of Directors in May 2006. Additionally, Mr. Rosen shall evaluate if the report is in keeping with the Guidelines for Child Custody Evaluations in Family Law Proceedings as approved by the American Psychological Association in February 2009 and California Rules of Court: 5.220 & 5.225.
2. Mr. Rosen agrees, after reading the report, to a telephone consultation with Attorney to discuss any concerns or findings. It is understood there may be more than one telephone consultation and up to (3) three hours of telephone contact are included in the fee.
3. Mr. Rosen will produce a report summarizing his findings, if requested by Attorney. Consultations and/or a summary report will be produced by Mr. Rosen within 60 (sixty) days of receiving payment and all relevant data or a time mutually agreed upon with Attorney.

Attorney shall:

1. Provide Mr. Rosen with a legible copy of the EC 730 evaluation within 30 days of signing this letter of engagement.
2. Attorney will obtain from 730 evaluator, the evaluator's entire case file including all forms, interviews, testing (raw and scored), collaterals and other data used to formulate evaluator's report. The case file shall be sent to Mr. Rosen's Temecula office: 43537 Ridge Park Drive # 107, Temecula, CA 92590.

3. Provide Mr. Rosen with a list of concerns regarding the 730 within 30 days of signing this letter of engagement. While it is certainly likely Attorney will consult with their client regarding the client's concerns, all communication will be between Attorney and Mr. Rosen. Mr. Rosen will not speak with or meet with client or their child unless ordered to do so by the court.
4. Provide Mr. Rosen with payment before any work commences on the part of Mr. Rosen. Payment may be made by mailing a check or through Mr. Rosen's website: mrosenmft.com and making payment with debit or credit card. Payment is acceptable either from Attorney's office or Client however client is not to contact Mr. Rosen directly.

The cost for reviewing the 730 evaluation, an email to attorney with concerns and a telephone consultation is \$1,500.00 (fifteen hundred dollars). A formal written summary of Mr. Rosen's findings shall be an additional \$1,500.00 (fifteen hundred dollars). These fees exclude Court Testimony, which is billed separately. The fee is non-refundable once Mr. Rosen has read the EC 730.

Mr. Rosen will be available to testify in Court or act as an Expert Advisor in Court. Court Testimony/Expert Advisor in Court is billed at the rate of \$3,000.00 (three thousand dollars) per court day or \$2,000 (two thousand dollars) for the am or pm portion. These charges are incurred whether or not testimony is given and 72 hours notice is required to refund the required deposit which is due (10) ten business days before the scheduled Court Hearing.
